SENIORS AT RISK ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

About The Program

The men and women of the Marion County Sheriff's Office are committed to meeting the needs of our growing senior community with integrity and respect.

We work closely with the Marion County Senior Services, Aging & Adult Services of the Department of Children & Families, and many other agencies in Marion County who also offer resources and information to assist you.

As part of our commitment to you, we have available the **Seniors At Risk Assistance Program (S.A.R.A.)**. This program is designed to give us the opportunity to provide personal contact with persons who live alone or have special needs that we should be aware of in order to better serve and protect them.

You can get further information or make a referral to this program by contacting your closest district office or by calling 352-369-6745 and asking for a Crisis Intervention Specialist.

How It Works

1. A referral is received from a citizen, family member, health care provider, or other concerned persons and forwarded to the Crisis Intervention Unit.
2. A personal visit is made to the home of the possible "at risk" senior by a Crisis Intervention Specialist and/or Deputy.
3. An assessment is made to identify what services are in the home, or if any assistance is needed. Suggestions for home and personal safety are made at that time.
4. A **S.A.R.A. Program** packet, which includes emergency contact information, is completed and a copy is kept by Crisis Intervention Specialist Unit and the nearest district office for routine well being checks.
5. If applicable, the Crisis Intervention Specialist makes contact with community resources for in-home services, which could include daily delivery of meals, house keeping, or transportation to doctor's appointments, etc.
